

The Rovers Season Ticket Unique Prize Draw terms and conditions.

By participating in this competition (the "Competition"), you fully agree to accept these Competition Terms and Conditions (the "Competition T's&C's") together with any specific instructions and terms for such competition which may be mentioned on the relevant section of the Blackburn Rovers FC website (the "Competition information")

Blackburn Rovers FC (the "Club") may amend or cancel this competition, competition information or the Competition T's&C's at any time and without any prior notice to entrants. Any changes will be posted on the Club's website and in the Competition information.

1. Eligibility

The Competition is open to UK residents, aged 18 or over only. The Club may require proof of identity and age from entrants to the Competition.

Entrants to the Competition must have purchased either an 18-25, Adult or Senior Club season ticket for the 2019/20 EFL Championship campaign (the "Adult Season Ticket"). Any entrant who enters this Competition and pays for their Adult Season Ticket via the Direct Debit plan confirm that they will continue to pay all instalments required by the Direct Debit plan.

By entering this Competition, you warrant that all the information submitted by you is true, current and complete.

In order to be in with a chance to win any of the prizes in this Competition, you must attend Ewood Park on 28th September 2019. The prize draw will take place at half time during the game against Luton Town FC.

Employees of the Club or their family members or anyone else connected with the Competition or helping to set up the Competition are not be eligible to enter the Competition.

Corporate season ticket holders and holders of a free carer season ticket are not eligible to enter the Competition.

100 Club members are eligible for this competition.

2. Competition Information and Selection Process.

Entry to the Competition is free **BUT** is dependent upon the entrant having bought an Adult Season Ticket.

The Competition will be open to those who have already purchased their Adult Season Ticket and to those who purchase their Adult Season Ticket prior to the 16th September 2019. Closing date for the competition will be 17:00 on 16th September 2019. After this date no further entries will be allowed.

Only one entry is permitted for each purchase of an Adult Season Ticket.

The winner will be chosen by a live, random draw from all entries received by the closing date, and verified by the Club and or its agent, during the game against Luton Town FC on 28th September 2019.

The live, random draw occurring is dependent upon the Club achieving the target of selling 10,000 Adult Season Tickets for the 2019-20 EFL Championship campaign.

The winner will be notified during the live draw and will receive confirmation by email and/or telephone within 24 hours. In order to accept the prize, the winner will be required to communicate their acceptance to the Club within 24 hours of being offered the prize.

3. Prize

The prize consists of £10,000.00 cash

The prize is subject to these Competition T's&C's. By accepting the prize, the winner agrees to comply with these Competition T's&C's.

The prize is non-refundable and non-transferable.

The Club reserves the right to cancel the draw if they do not achieve the target of selling 10,000 Adult Season Tickets for the 2019-20 EFL Championship campaign.

The Club cannot promise that the services relating to the Competition will be free from errors or omissions.
